

Graduation 2020

So much is dependent upon the next round of restrictions after May 15. Hopefully, next week we can release a final plan with more details. At this moment, we are planning for best and worst case scenarios and will adapt accordingly. This is not exactly how any of us wanted to proceed, but I appreciate your patience.

We are preparing two plans for graduation on May 23 at 2:00 pm.

- Plan A – if state restrictions have lessened
- Plan B – if state restrictions have not changed or are more restrictive

We plan to utilize the Zoom app or a livestreaming service to record graduation. This will allow everyone in attendance to view and hear (on their personal, data-enabled device) all of the graduation ceremony while maintaining social distancing and also provide access to those not in attendance.

- I will send out details later regarding which service we will use to record and broadcast graduation and any appropriate links you will need to view the event.

Graduates need to prepare a brief write-up to be read as they are introduced while receiving their diploma (i.e., introducing your parents, your post-graduation plans, best memories of school days, express thanks to parents/families/teachers, etc...) ---less than one minute in length. (In any case, no personal community interaction will be possible and the **school facilities will not be open** to the public on the day of graduation. **No restrooms will be available** during the event, and families should plan accordingly. Graduates and guests should arrive completely dressed and ready for the event to begin.)
